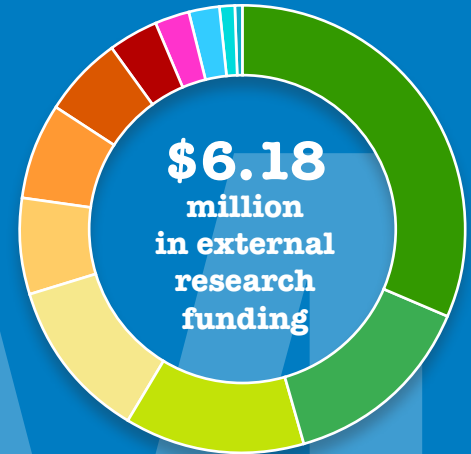

We launched a new \$25 million fundraising campaign to expand Holland Bloorview's research institute, marking the largest research expansion in the organization's history.

Health promotion program helps build life skills

Holland Bloorview helped a group of youth build friendships while building practical life skills through a new health promotion pilot program called *Mind. Body. Mingle*. This eight-week program gives youth with disabilities the chance to learn new ways to be healthier mentally and emotionally, get active, and get connected to the community and to each other.

Concussion program eases pain for both kids and parents

The Concussion Centre at Holland Bloorview is easing the pain of concussion and supporting kids and families along the way. The *On TRACK Health Professional Student Training Program* is an exciting new approach to training the next generation of pediatric concussion experts.

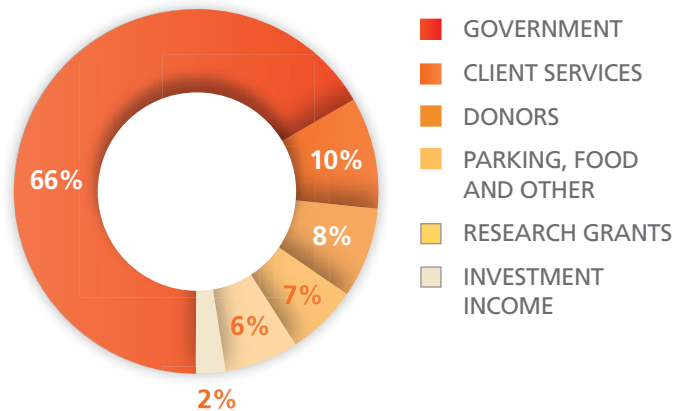
Canadian study identifies genetic link in cause of cerebral palsy

Scientists at Holland Bloorview and SickKids identified a genetic link that may explain how cerebral palsy (CP) develops in utero. This is the first study to suggest a much stronger genetic link in kids with hemiplegic CP – the most common type of CP.

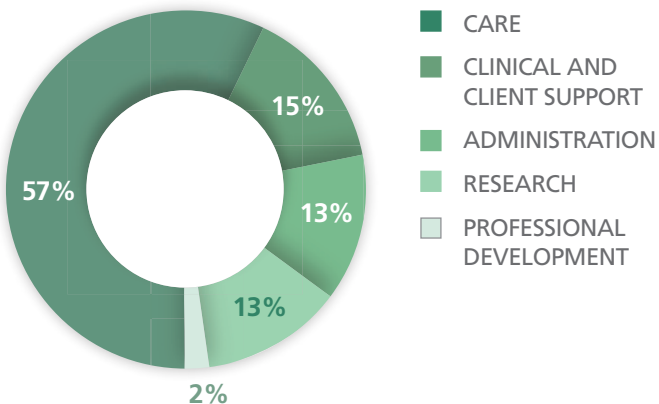

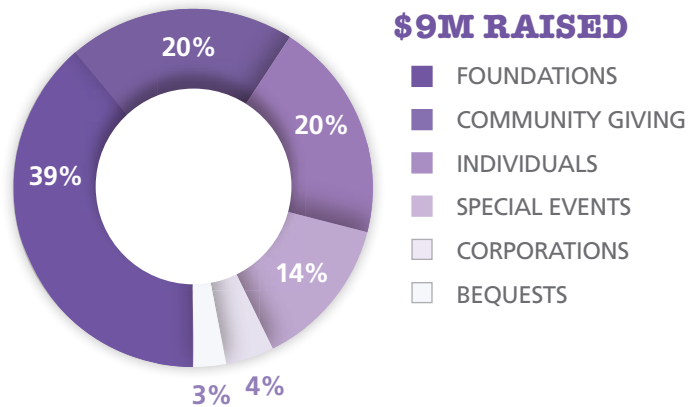
WHERE DO HOSPITAL FUNDS COME FROM?



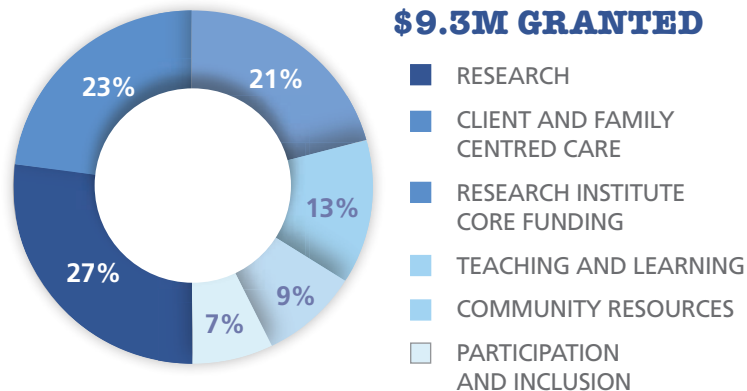
HOW DO WE SPEND HOSPITAL FUNDS?

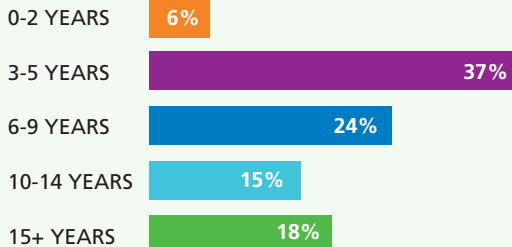

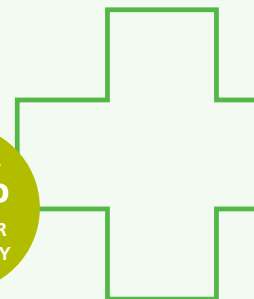
