

# Baby CIMT Clinic

## About the Baby CIMT Clinic

The clinic provides assessment to infants who have a high probability of, or who have a diagnosis of hemiplegic cerebral palsy. Clinicians will receive consultation and support for implementation of Baby CIMT. The clinic provides no active therapy.

## How to make a referral to Baby CIMT

## Referral criteria

- The infant lives in Toronto.
- The infant is between the ages of 3-21 months.
- The infant has asymmetrical hand use, has a diagnosis of, or is identified to have high probability of, hemiplegic cerebral palsy.
- The infant is involved with community services (i.e. OT, PT, EI).

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Physician referral to Baby CIMT Clinic

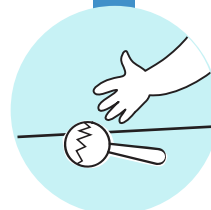


Infant receives:

Clinician (OT, PT, EI) receives:

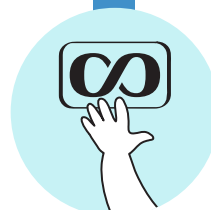
- ✓ consultation and support for implementing Baby CIMT home program
