

Stepping Stones to Rehabilitation Nursing

A Pediatric Rehabilitation Course for Nurses

September 26-28, 2011

Course Description:

This course is designed for Registered Nurses and Registered Practical Nurses who work with children and adolescents who have disabilities and/or chronic illnesses. Nurses who work in acute care, rehabilitation, schools, homes and community settings will be presented with up to date information on rehabilitation nursing care of children and adolescents. Your knowledge of current rehabilitation nursing interventions for children with various disabilities will be enhanced.

Who Should Attend?

Registered Nurses and Registered Practical Nurses, who work with children and adolescents with disabilities or chronic illness or nurses that work in adult rehab setting and want to gain a better understanding of pediatric rehabilitation nursing. Small class size will contribute to a positive learning experience. Minimum registration required to run the course.

Course Objectives:

Upon completion of this course participants will be able to:

- Describe the major pathophysiological states occurring with prolonged illness and disability
- Identify nursing interventions for rehabilitation clients and families within an interdisciplinary model of care, which will meet individual needs and promote positive client outcomes
- Enhance interprofessional collaboration and communication skills
- Function as key participant in the discharge planning process
