

Electronic Aids to Daily Living (EADL)

Costs and funding

Holland Bloorview's electronic aids to daily living (EADL) is offered on a fee-for-service basis, with a cost of \$120 for the initial assessment. Following the assessment, the team will provide a quote for the recommended EADL equipment including labour costs for the EADL system design, development and installation.

The Ontario government, including the Assistive Devices Program (ADP) of the Ministry of Health and Long Term Care, does not provide financial assistance for the cost of EADL equipment or services. Families and clients are encouraged to apply for external funding to help cover the cost of the EADL service and equipment.
