The Bloorview Research Institute at Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital is proud to present the annual Pursuit Award.

The award recognizes PhD students from across the globe for their outstanding achievements in childhood disability research. Universities with doctoral programs may nominate one candidate. The PhD thesis topic of the nominee must be childhood disability.

The award is presented yearly under the following categories:

- 2012 - Health Research
- 2013 - Social Sciences
- 2014 - Natural Sciences and Engineering

The top three candidates will present at the awards ceremony in Toronto, Canada and compete for first prize - \$7,500.

Deadline for submission is February 1, 2012, 5 pm EST
