The school year has started. Youth in grade 10, 11 or 12, whom we have seen developing and maturing before our eyes, are starting to take concrete steps to get ready for college or university.

On Saturday, November 26, 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m., Holland Bloorview will host an information session for students with a physical and /or a learning disability and their families to help them start planning for entry to college/university.

Holland Bloorview staff, along with representatives from colleges/universities will provide information to help students plan academically, socially and financially. Representatives from community agencies will also be present at the resource displays to provide information about supports available.

Youth who have recently entered college/university programs will share their experiences and answer questions.

Parents who have experienced this part of their son's or daughter's transition will also share stories.

After the 2010 session youth and their parents said:

- "It helped to get all this info about how to get ready and helps me to understand what I have to do ."
- "It is my responsibility to get things done and ask questions."
