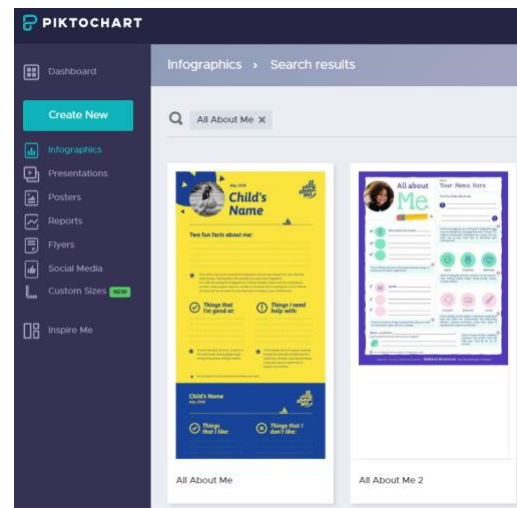
## Free programs to create infographics

You can create your own infographic by using a free, online program. In these programs you can add icons, pictures, backgrounds, and more. Here are three examples of programs you can use:

- [Canva](#)
- [Piktochart](#)
- [Visme](#)

Before you can use any of these programs, you will first need to create a free account. Pick the program you like best, click on the link, and then press “sign up”.

All of these programs have many templates to choose from to build your infographic. Piktochart has two free templates that were created for Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital. You can find them by searching “all about me” in the infographics tab. The picture on the right shows how to find them (zoom in).
